



## **Coach Report – Thursday, Friday and Saturday 2nd, 3rd & 4<sup>th</sup> August**

### **Swim England National Summer Championships 2018 at Ponds Forge, Sheffield**

Day 3 Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> August at Swim England summer meet and Beachfield's Genny Hunter had her best finish to date in in the women's MC 400 free finishing 15 th just off pb and 308 points

Day 4 Friday 3 August

Brandon arrived fresh as a daisy with a shiny new retro haircut, swimming in heat 3 of the men's 15 yrs 50 m breaststroke ranked 13 th, he raced to make 7 th place for the final and a pb

Genny returned to swim the 100 fly a difficult event for an S8 she swam to 11 th place - her best finish of the meet

Brandon returned for the final of the 15 yrs old 100 brst up with the leaders at the half way mark racing to the 50 just a tenth of a second off his entry time

a fast speed and was ahead of her paces at the 15/25 and 50 mark , so we knew a good time was on the cards tuning on 52.02 , Genny put another good shift in on the back end to finish in a pb time of 1.46.50 a four and a half second improvement , after entering the meet carrying a shoulder injury Genny demonstrated resilience and fortitude throughout the meet to finally pb in her last event meaning everyone at nationals has achieved at least one pb
