Beachfield swimming Squad continued to impress at day two of the 2019 Kent county swimming championships held at the Queen Elizabeth pk, London aquatics centre Stratford Sprinter Callie Ann bravely took on the 800 free in the 17 yrs and over finishing in 8th place and a point for the club.

Session 5 finals

15 yr old Brandon Harris stormed to his first Gold of the 2019 championships to go with his two silvers yesterday staking his claim in the first 15 meters with a stunning underwater demolition of the opposition. Brandon led from the front and refused to let go taking 6 tenths of his long course pb, nice swim

Callie improved her finals time going under the 30 barrier but just getting touched out in to 5th place 3 one hundredths of a second separating 5th from second place, Jodie collecting 7th and some vital extra points for the club well done girls.

Session 6

Tj made her appearance at counties in the girls 17 yrs and over 50 brst, Lily Durnford continued to battle away in the girls 15 yrs 50 brst finishing in 13th place and a long course pb.

Josh Baar racked up another pb in the boys 15 yrs 50 free, Ed Dickinson swam well in the 17 yrs and over 50 free one hundredth of a second off pb. Brandon knocked a second off his long course pb in the boys 16 yrs 50 free. Oliie Durant finished up for us with a 6 tenths pb in the boys 50 free 17 yrs and over age group

And that wrapped up the second day at The County Championships 2019.
