Conditions of entry

1. **Facilities: K2 Leisure Centre, Pease Pottage Hill, Crawley RH11 9BQ.**
2. The competition will be swum under A.S.A. Laws and Technical rules and licensed by the ASA. All clubs submitting entries are requested to assist in the running of the meet by supplying details of any licensed officials who are willing to assist at this Gala.
3. **Ages as at June 15th 2019 (last day of the meet). Entries accepted from 7am on 24th April 2019. Closing date for entries is the 20th May 2019 (midnight) or when the meet is full.**
4. All events will be run on a heat declared winner (HDW) basis. The last heat in each event will be spearheaded. **50m (long course) entry times should be submitted. SC converted times will also be accepted.**
5. All entries must be within the upper and lower qualifying times for the individual age. Entries to be accepted on a '**First come first served**' basis, and some events and sessions may become fully subscribed sooner than others. .
6. Any empty lanes may be filled by rejected Crawley swimmers.
7. Awards will be given in single age groups to (9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16 and 17+) placed 1st to 3rd without disqualification. These awards can be collected from the awards table poolside.
8. Entry fees are £6 for 50s, 100s & 200s. **Entries will be via email on the Hy-tek software available to download free from the Hy-tek website. Entries not via Hytek will incur a £10 admin fee.** Entries must be sent with payment by bank transfer. Coach Passes are £10 which will entitle the holder to admission to all sessions, a program and poolside refreshments (not food). Passes must be displayed at all times.
9. **Entries on the day/Time Trials** - Entry to an event on the day by swimmers already accepted into the meet may be possible if a lane becomes available in a heat, no new heats will be added to an event. Competitors wishing to swim time trials should register their interest at the electronics desk at the end of the spectator's gallery, as soon as possible, (no later than the start of each session prior to warm up). There will be a charge of £10.00 per time trial, payable at time of entry. There will be no awards for TT's and will be entered as exhibition swims, but times achieved will go to Rankings.
10. **Active withdrawal** system will operate. Forms will be available poolside and on the desk. **Withdrawals must be made before the start of the session warm up or can be emailed in advance.**
11. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the closing other than withdrawals for medical reasons that are accompanied by the appropriate certification.

12. Competitors for the first event in each session must report to the marshalling area immediately after each warm-up. For other events, competitors should report when called. It is the swimmers and their coaches' responsibility that they report to the marshals on time. There will be NO announcements calling late swimmers.
13. All meet participants and spectators must observe all safety precautions in operation at K2 Crawley Leisure Centre and follow the instructions of pool staff.
14. Swimmers must not go up to the balcony without first drying off and putting on footwear and clothing before leaving the poolside.
15. Competitors are advised not to leave their belongings unattended and to ensure that all valuables are placed in a locked locker (a returnable £1 coin). We will be restricting the size of bags taken poolside at this event. Only a small drawstring type bag will be permitted. Oversized bags will be removed and must be placed in lockers. Neither Crawley Swimming Club nor K2 Crawley Leisure Centre can accept responsibility for any property that may be lost or stolen.
16. Spectator entry is £3 per session, £7 for the day plus £2 per programme (children free) and all adult spectators are required to wear appropriate coloured wristbands for each session. **Anyone NOT wearing their wristband may be refused re-entry.**
17. It is requested that all mobile phones are switched off or to silent during the competition and that there is no flash photography at the start of each event.
18. All visiting clubs must ensure that team managers and coaches are DBS checked and comply with the Swim England Child Protection Policy. Team Managers/Coaches will be allowed on poolside if wearing a pre-purchased pass. No pass, no admission poolside. Coaches and Team Managers must be club trained personnel and clubs are asked to maintain the recommended ratio of 1:10. Untrained parents without DBS checks are NOT allowed poolside.

Data protection with the submission of entries. Consent is deemed to have been given, as required of the data protection act, to the holding and distribution as necessary, of personal information on computer, to run the meet. The promoters reserve the right to close the meet when the scheduled events are full.
